# **Maximizing Benefits from Community Investments**

The Cape Charles Main Street organization makes the most of every dollar it fundraises or receives to spearhead vital downtown business support initiatives, beautification projects and major community events:

### **Downtown Business Support**

- Delivered and managed a grant totaling \$896,115 in Small Business Recovery Assistance benefiting 88 Cape Charles businesses over 18 months.
- Partnering with the town in the development of much needed public bathrooms and visitor center with financial support through grants.
- Printing and distributing 62,000 copies of Discover Cape Charles map to key travel locations across the Mid-Atlantic.
  - Holding monthly Main Street Connect meetings, keeping town businesses abreast of developments and opportunities.
    - Responsible for building and managing the Cape Charles Virginia's Cape website and Cape Charles Main Street microsite with engaging new content driving 117,692 new users and 370,516 views in the 18 months since it launched. Visit

### **Train Revitalization & Visitor Center**

The Cape Charles Main Street organization plays a key role in the vision planning and grant funding for a new visitor center and ADA accessible public restrooms that will

serve as the gateway to downtown. With a nod to preserving Cape Charles' railroad heritage, the facility will feature a rehabilitated train car surrounded by story boards, along with a brick-and-mortar building housing the Main Street offices. Plans also call for an outdoor play area for children.

We are looking to expand our tree lighting up and down Mason Avenue and keep the lights up throughout the winter season!
